Details About the Bootcamp

Why The Bootcamp

Outbox EDU seeks to create 200,000 job opportunities by 2030.

This is our north star and our ultimate goal as a program. The boot camp serves that goal by not only training young talent in software development but also fostering their career kickstart through soft skills training, a work simulative and problem solving intensive curriculum, and finally a career kickstart through virtual internships.

At the end of the 20 week bootcamp...

- You will be a fully skilled fullstack javascript developer with the ability to work in either back end or front end development
- You will qualify to work as a junior software developer with knowledge of high in demand languages
- You will be equipped with a range of high-in-demand career-based skills like communication, project presentation, teamwork, global standard cv writing which are markable to many reputable employers
- You will be enrolled into our virtual internships program for the next three months. The internships will provide you with more experience to kick start your career

Bootcamp process flow



The boot camp will comprise of 4 key parts. Admissions/Enrollment, Prep/Introduction, the Boot camp, Virtual internships.

On admission, all learners new to software development will undergo a 5 week preparation class where they will learn all the basics of coding and be assessed on preparedness. Those that pass will then go through a 4 month FullStack course (both frontend and backend) and after graduation, they will all be enrolled into our guaranteed 3 month virtual internships program.

Note:

The Virtual Internships program is part of the boot camp and will be open and accessible to all Boot camp participants that complete their fees before graduation.

Start date and duration

Bootcamp begins on 1st March 2021, of which you will undergo five weeks of understanding the coding fundamental before undertaking the four month FullStack Course.



The Bootcamp Curriculum

Course Content	Learning Points	Outcomes
Fundamentals (5 weeks)	HTML, CSS, JS, Git, Reactjs, Nodejs	Building an interactive static personal Portfolio website that provides your professional information and presents a showcase of your work.
JAM Stack (8 weeks)	Build Installs and Tasks, CDN - Netlify, Backend Services, API Economy, Headless CMS, Utility API, Cloud Functions	Building an e-commerce web application (like Jumia) without a backend that allows users to shop for items, and place items in a cart.
Node Js Full Stack MVC Framework Projects (7 weeks)	Express Generator, Nextjs	Building a single e-commerce backend system to connect both to the customer's application (like Jumia) and the retailer's application.

Career Services

What should I expect from the Career Services team at Outbox

Our ultimate goal is to make sure all our trainees find employment, be it an internship, apprenticeship, learnership or a full-time job, we will be there to support you.

As part of the bootcamp, you will have access to the career services department that will be dedicated to finding you a job by offering

- Linkages to jobs available on the market
- Career advice and guidance as needed
- Assistance with your CV and other application documents
- Help with optimizing your linkedin profile
- Mock interview sessions and interview assistance.
- A placement in our Virtual Internships program

The Virtual Internships Program

Because Internships are vital to any career, as part of the Outbox EDU bootcamp, you become eligible for a placement in our virtual internship where you will get to work on and learn from projects with leading tech companies in and out of Uganda.

Only learners that will complete their program fees and graduation requirements will be eligible for the program

The Virtual Internships will run for a standard period of 3 months with the option to extend for another 3 months depending on one's performance.



Program Payment details

Payment Key Facts

- The Boot camp will cost Ugx 1,200,000 per participant
- All participants will be required to pay a mandatory **30%** of the overall fee as an admission/commitment fee which is equivalent to **Ugx 360,000**.
- All participants will have the freedom to flexibly pay the remaining 70% (Ugx 840, 000) without a stringent payment plan.
- However, to maintain a healthy payment path, we recommend that all participants try to complete their fees before Week 16.
- We will however require that all participants fully complete their fees before graduation day.
- Only those participants that have completed their fees will be eligible for the virtual internships

Study Hours

20 Hours per week on a rotational shift pattern from Monday to Friday.

Projects and Tests

You will have weekly tests followed by a project assignment at the end of every module. These assignments usually have a one week deadline, and assessed by the learning facilitators.

You will receive your ratings via email.

Class disbursement mode

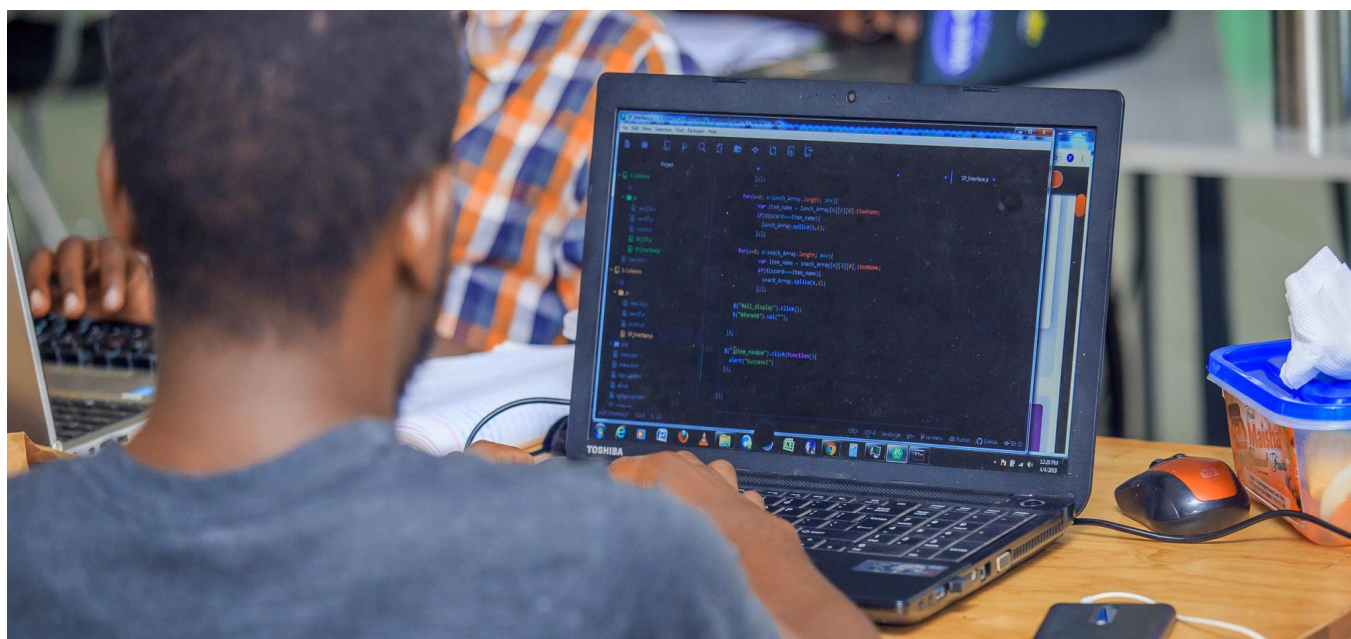
The classes will be carried out online starting at 10am. You are advised to have a stable internet connection to be able to fully take advantage of the resources the class provides.

Personal engagements with facilitators online are encouraged, and you will be shown how to book personal sessions with facilitators on Google Calendar.

Class Requirements

Below are the minimum requirements for your laptop to ensure that you have a smooth sailing during the Bootcamp:

- 4GB RAM
- 1.6 GHz or faster processor
- Windows 7/8/10, Ubuntu, or MacOS
- Must be able to have a reliable internet connection



The Admissions Process

In order to be successfully enrolled into the Outbox EDU Full Stack Web Development Boot camp, you will be required to go through three major stages;

- ***The Application Process***

The first step of your enrollment involves you filling in a detailed application form that requires your bio-data, educational background and next of kin.

- ***The Personality Test***

You will then be required to undertake a personality test so as to give us a meticulous view of your character traits.

- ***The Interview.***

You will then undergo a group virtual interview with the Admissions team.

During the interview, you will be asked questions relating to your motivations in life, educational background and your expectations from the class. You will also be given a chance to make inquiries. This interview will show us whether you are a suitable candidate for the class or not.

To prepare, make sure you have stable internet connection as the interview will be conducted over Zoom for not more than 30 minutes.

If you successfully pass the interview, you will be given an acceptance letter and a student agreement to sign, which will need to be submitted back together with proof of payment of at least 30% before you are enrolled.

- ***Outbox EDU Home Study***

Lastly, for you to prepare and make the best of your experience, you will be sent the Outbox EDU Home Study for you to read through and get acquainted with the concepts that you will be learning.



Expectations- What Outbox EDU Expects From You

Commitment

Your learning is a full time commitment; we expect you to fully commit to your learning. If you have any distractions while in class they are bound to derail your learning process. Imperfect attendance and external obligations are some of the things that might be a distraction and will inhibit your experience. If you are unable to attend all of Outbox EDU Full Stack Web Development Class, you must speak with Outbox EDU Admissions before joining.

Diversity and Inclusion

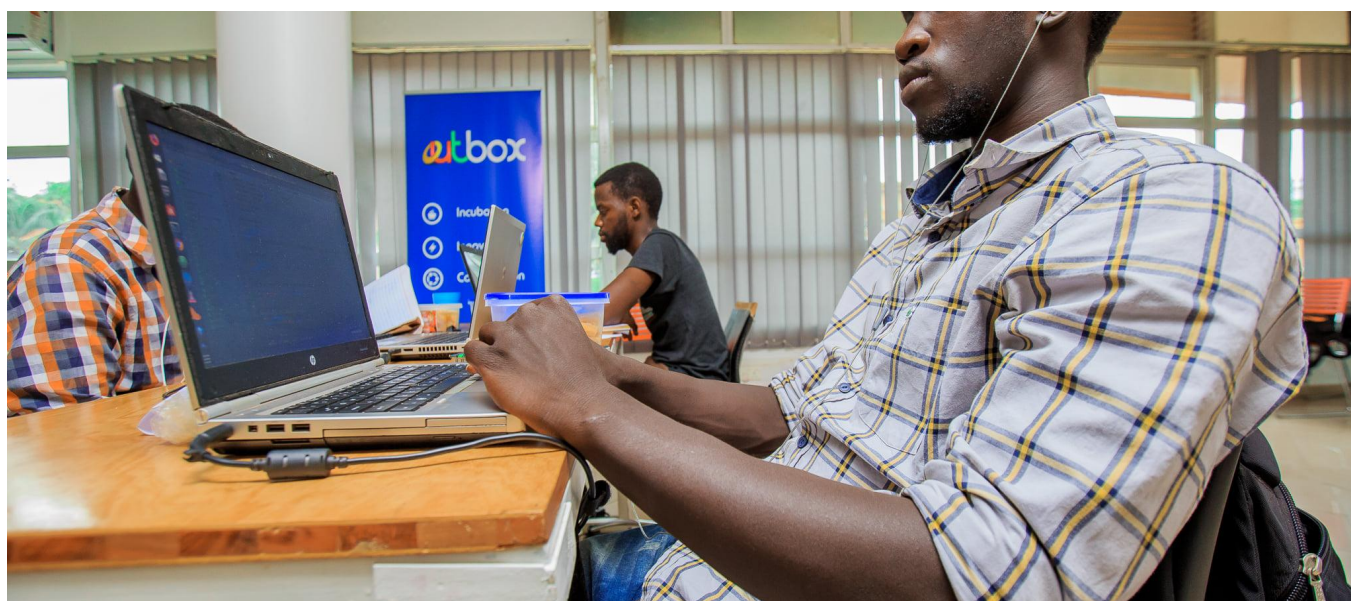

We have an Attendance Policy that simply states that you need to attend at least 70% of all your classes. Any form of absenteeism will be recorded and may result in us discontinuing your participation.

Fees Policy

The total boot camp fee is Ugx 1,200,000. However, students are required to pay at least 30% of this (Ugx 360,000) before joining the class. We offer flexible payment plans for the balance which should be completed before graduation.
